under the name of Anna Klara Zeuner (4) I declare my intention to become a citizen of the United States on November 28, 1933 in the U.S. District Court of Southern District at New York, N.Y.

(5) I am not married. It is my intention to become a citizen of the United States and to renounce absolutely and forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, or sovereignty, and particularly to _____

The German Reich of whom (which) at this time I am a subject (or citizen), and it is my intention to reside permanently in the United States. (8) I am able to speak the English language. (9) I have resided continuously in the United States of America for the term of five years at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since April 27, 1926 in the County of New York this State, continuously next preceding the date of this petition, since April 1926 being a residence within said county of at least six months next preceding the date of this petition.
